## Comptroller Lierman to Celebrate Opening of Baltimore Office, Kick Off Tax Season

**BALTIMORE, Md. (January 22, 2024)** — On Tuesday, January 23, at 11 a.m., **Comptroller Brooke E. Lierman** will host a ribbon-cutting celebration to open the Office of the Comptroller's Baltimore Branch Office at its new downtown location.

The Office of the Comptroller is the first state agency to relocate its Baltimore office from the State Center Complex to downtown Baltimore. This move will enhance the work experience for agency employees, improve the customer experience for taxpayers in Baltimore, and make a meaningful investment in downtown Baltimore.

Comptroller Lierman will also highlight changes and priorities for modernizing the tax filing process in Maryland. The 2024 tax season begins for personal income tax filers on January 29, 2024. Corporate tax filing season is already underway.
