Board of Public Works Approves \$388.6 Million for Projects Across Maryland

ANNAPOLIS, Md. (March 19, 2025) —Comptroller Brooke E. Lierman today joined Lt. Governor Aruna Miller and Chief Deputy Treasurer Jonathan D. Martin for a meeting of the Board of Public Works and approved more than \$388.6 million in funding for 123 items impacting communities across Maryland.

The Board of Public Works approved contracts worth \$388,600,701.44, including:

- Grant agreements for 24 recipients for 25 projects located in nine counties and Baltimore City with a total value of \$12,642,500
- 17 items awarding \$14,833,652.67 to prime certified small business primes
- Eight items awarding \$10,537,613.83 to certified minority business enterprise primes
- One item awarding \$294,549.46 to an Employment Works Program provider
- 12 items awarded with established participation goals for minority business enterprises

The next meeting of the Board of Public Works is April 2, 2025.
