Comptroller Lierman to Release Climate Cost Report April 22

Earth Day event to focus on opportunities to improve climate resilience in Maryland

ANNAPOLIS, Md. (April 17, 2025) — Comptroller Brooke E. Lierman will host a press conference marking Earth Day and releasing the second report in the Comptroller's State Spending series Tuesday, April 22, 2025, at the Treasury Building in Annapolis.

The report outlines the effects of climate change and extreme weather events on Maryland and the investments that could be made to increase the state's climate resilience over the long term.

Comptroller Lierman and members of the Maryland General Assembly will also discuss an upcoming study on the costs of greenhouse gas emissions to the state.

Following the press conference, climate experts will participate in two panel discussions focused on the impact of climate change on Maryland, building climate resilience, and future opportunities for investment.
