Preliminary findings to guide future promotion of Earned Income Tax Credit and Child Tax Credit

ANNAPOLIS, Md. (July 15, 2025) — Comptroller Brooke E. Lierman will be joined on Thursday, July 17, 2025, by Governor Wes Moore, Maryland House Speaker Adrienne Jones, Governor's Office of Children Special Secretary Carmel Martin, senior researchers from the Urban Institute, and state and community partners to discuss their collaborative work to increase awareness and uptake of individual income tax credits for eligible low and middle-income Marylanders.
