TODAY: Comptroller Lierman to Testify on Economic Impact of SNAP Benefits on Maryland

ANNAPOLIS, Md. (October 29, 2025) — Comptroller Brooke E. Lierman will testify this afternoon before the House Appropriations Committee and the Senate Budget and Taxation Committee on the economic impact SNAP Benefits have on Maryland's economy, families, and small businesses.

Funding for the federal Supplemental Nutritional Assistance Program will expire on November 1, 2025, leaving thousands of Marylanders without food assistance.
