Comptroller Brooke E. Lierman to Host Ribbon Cutting for New Branch Office in Baltimore County

Windsor Mill Branch Office to offer more convenient, accessible location for Marylanders seeking tax assistance

ANNAPOLIS, Md. (November 4, 2025) — Comptroller Brooke E. Lierman will host a cutting on Thursday, November 6, 2025, for the new Baltimore County Branch Office in Windsor Mill. Comptroller Lierman will be joined by state and local leaders during the celebration, including Baltimore County Executive Kathy Klausmeier, and Speaker Adrienne A. Jones.

The new office offers ground-floor access, free parking, accessibility by public transit, and close proximity to I-695 (the Baltimore Beltway). The Baltimore County Branch Office was previously located in Towson for 31 years. The new location was chosen for its increased visibility and modern amenities.
