

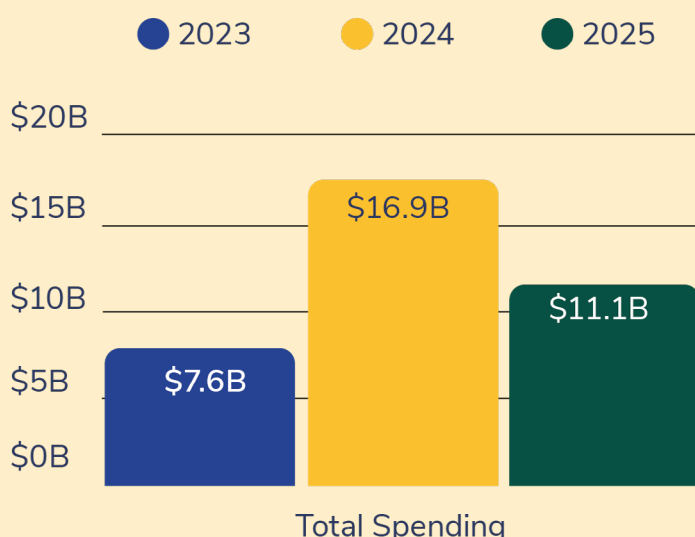
BPW 2025 ANNUAL SNAPSHOT

In 2025, BPW approved 2,028 agenda items for a total of **\$11.1 billion** in state spending.

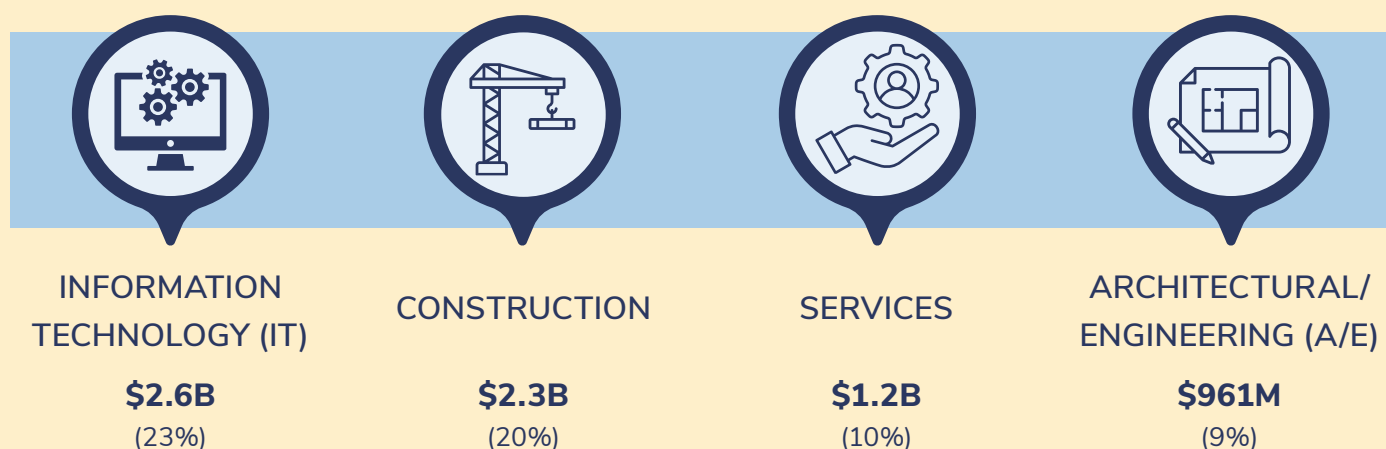
TRENDS

Spending declined in 2025 from 2024, but remained above 2023 levels, primarily driven by **investments in health and human services, energy assistance, public infrastructure, transportation, and digital services.**

Higher BPW spending in 2024 was largely due to several multi-year contracts for healthcare services for Marylanders.

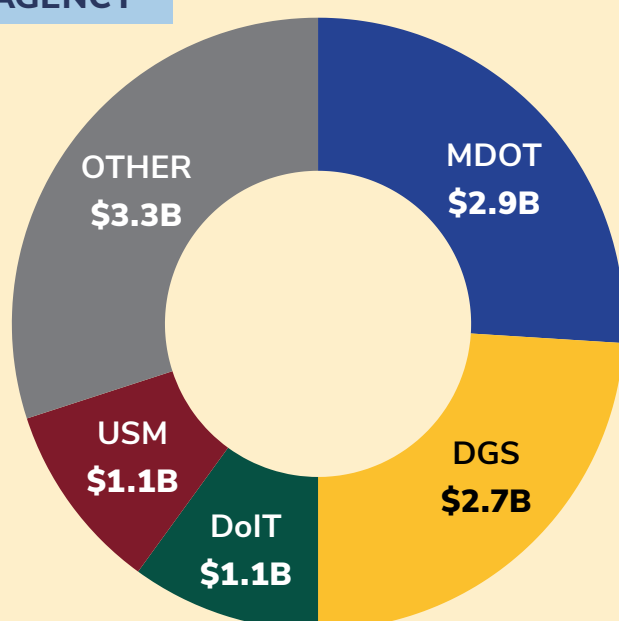
